Updates/History of Briefing:

The City Council directed the city manager to begin the process of eliminating dead-end water mains within the current water infrastructure. The city's fund balance was to be earmarked and used for these future projects.

Executive Summary and Background Information:

Bids were received Tuesday, January 28, 2020 for the South Texarkana – Looping Dead-end Mains. Four (4) contractors picked up bid packages for the project and one (1) contractor bid on the project. Kampco, Inc. of Texarkana, Arkansas, was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$491,554.38. This project is the first phase of a multi-phase project to eliminate as many dead-end mains as financially feasible. This first phase consists of installing approximately 8,000 linear feet of six-inch (6") water mains, 105 linear feet of four-inch (4") water mains, tapping sleeves, gate valves, and fire hydrants in the south Texarkana area. This project will eliminate 27 dead ends which will improve the quality of the water as well as eliminate the need to flush these dead ends monthly as required by TCEQ.

This resolution will amend the budget estimate of the revenue and expenditures of the Texarkana Water Utilities Texas Capital Improvement Fund (Fund 62) for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and ending September 30, 2020, to add available funds of \$625,000.00 for this project.

OF TEXARKANA, ARKANSAS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND 38 CENTS (\$491,554.38) FOR THE SOUTH TEXARKANA LOOPING DEAD END MAINS PROJECT; AMENDING BUDGETED EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF TEXARKANA, TEXAS, GENERAL FUND (FUND 101) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$625,000.00; AMENDING BUDGETED REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE TEXARKANA WATER UTILITIES TEXAS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (FUND 62) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$625,000.00; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2020, one (1) bid was received, a copy of which is attached hereto as **ATTH01**, by Texarkana Water Utilities for the South Texarkana – Looping Dead End Mains Project; and

WHEREAS, the project will consist of installing approximately 8,000 linear feet of six-inch (6”) water mains, 105 linear feet of four-inch (4”) water mains, tapping sleeves, gate valves, and fire hydrants, and related appurtenances; and

WHEREAS, the sole and best bid by a responsible vendor for this project was submitted by Kampco, Inc. of Texarkana, Arkansas, a copy of which is attached hereto as **ATTH02** in an amount not to exceed \$491,554.38; and

WHEREAS, estimated contingency costs for the project total \$133,445.62; and

WHEREAS, funds for the project are reserved in the City of Texarkana General Fund; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends amending the budget estimate of the expenditures of the City of Texarkana, Texas General Fund (Fund 101) for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and ending September 30, 2020, to add available funds of \$625,000.00; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends amending the budget estimate of the revenue and expenditures of the Texarkana Water Utilities Texas Capital Improvement Fund (Fund 62) for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and ending September 30, 2020, to add available funds of \$625,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEXARKANA, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the sole and best bid by a responsible vendor, submitted by Kampco, Inc. of Texarkana, Arkansas, a copy of which is attached hereto as **ATTH02** be and is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$491,554.38 for the installation of water mains and related appurtenances for the South Texarkana – Looping Dead End Mains Project.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to allocate contingency to the project as needed in an amount not to exceed \$133,445.62.

SECTION 3: That the budget estimate of the expenditures of the City of Texarkana, Texas, as prepared by the City Manager and appropriated by the City Council for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and ending September 30, 2020, be amended to reflect additional expenditures of \$625,000.00 appropriated in the City's General Fund (Fund 101).

SECTION 4: That the budget estimate of the revenue and expenditures of the City of Texarkana, Texas, as prepared by the City Manager and appropriated by the City Council for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019, and ending September 30, 2020, be amended to reflect additional revenue and expenditures of \$625,000.00 appropriated in the Texarkana Water Utilities Texas Capital Improvement Fund (Fund 62).

SECTION 5: That the City Manager be and is authorized to contract with Kampco, Inc. of Texarkana, Arkansas, for the above-described services.

SECTION 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
